About Our Speaker and Course



Raymond Fonseca, DMD

Dr. Fonseca received his DMD degree from the University Connecticut School of Dental Medicine in 1973 and completed his oral surgery residency at Parkland Memorial Hospital Dallas in 1976. He received his certification from the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in 1978.

Following his postgraduate training, he held the position of assistant professor and associate director of Graduate Education at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. In 1980, Dr. Fonseca joined the faculty of the University of Iowa as associate professor and director of the Graduate Education in the department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.

Dr. Fonseca was chairman and professor of Oral Medicine, Pathology and Surgery at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry from 1982-1989. From 1989 to 2003, Dr. Fonseca was the dean of the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine. He has published 62 articles, 15 book chapters, 27 abstracts and 7 major books. He is also the editor of the seven

volume text of *Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery* published in July 2000. He was awarded the *Outstanding Educator* award, the *Distinguished Researcher* award, the *Gies* award, The *W. Harry Archer* award and is a fellow of the International College of Dentists.
